1. Sue Binion, President -
 - a. December meeting replaced with Teacher breakfast on the 17th. No new business was offered at that time.

2. Treasurer - Kristin presented the treasurer report/balance and advised many line items in our budget came in higher than average this year. She advised some grant receipts not turned in yet, in addition to the two grants not switched over to discretionary funds.
3. Principal report - Danny Brothers joined the meeting to advise the current goings on at the school. He spoke of the Navarre Marine Science Experiment with Ms. Kosky and

4. SAC Rep. –

 - b. She also reported SAC has \$5,543.00 in their budget.
5. Project Grad. –

6. Programs –
 - a. Tonya Goodroe set up a grant writing workshop for Jan 27th with the Gulf Breeze Will Do group. The officers of the group will speak with teachers and parents of all local schools, about the benefits of this philanthropic organization. It is designed to award funds from \$1000.00 up to \$10,000.00 - solely geared towards 32561 and 32563 recipients.
