CAPE Academy received a check for \$39,000. This money will be used to improve technology and pay for the accreditation tests. All certification tests that are passed in Mrs. Renfroe and Mrs. Folse classes also help accumulate points for the A school rating. Health Academy also accumulates points for the school.
