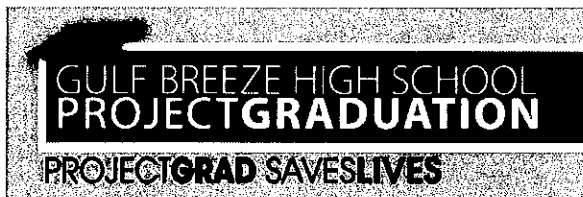

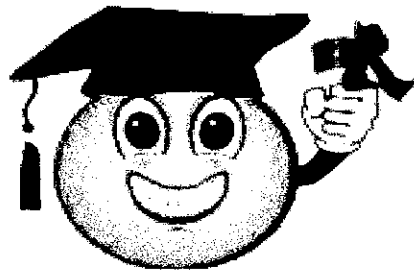

b) **Join online:**

Visit remind.com/join and enter the code along with your mobile phone number. You'll get text notifications at the number you entered.

2) **Get mobile app notifications.**

a) Download the mobile app for iOS and Android devices and create a new account (or log in if you already have one.) To join a class, tap the + by Classes Joined and either join with your class code or search for your class. You'll automatically get app notifications.

3) **Get email notifications.**

Why Use Remind?

Remind helps you stay connected

You are your child's first teacher. Student success depends on the support of networks that include parents, teachers, and other key stakeholders in their school communities.

To strengthen these partnerships, teachers are using Remind to bring learning home. Remind is a free, safe messaging app that keeps families up to date with what's happening in the classroom.

Teachers can send messages to an entire class, smaller groups, or individuals. These quick, simple messages can help you and your student stay informed about:

- Homework assignments
- Field trip updates
- Schedule changes
- Personalized support or feedback
- And more!

Remind is safe

- Personal contact information stays private. Phone numbers aren't exchanged between teachers, students, and parents.
- Messages can't be edited or deleted, so a complete message history is always available to access and download.
- Everyone has the ability to report users who violate Remind's Community Guidelines.
- Students under the age of 13 need to enter a parent or guardian's email address before using Remind. They can only receive messages from their teachers.

Remind is accessible

- Teachers can use Remind to reach students and parents on any device, including texting-only phones—no smartphones necessary.
- Students and parents can receive Remind messages by text (in the United States and Canada), email, and push notifications on the app.

- Remind is free to use for teachers, students, and parents. Standard text messaging and data rates may apply, so check to see if you're on a per-text phone plan or a limited data plan. You can always log in to your account on the web.
- The mobile app is available in six different languages. If you use Remind in Spanish, French, Simplified Chinese, Portuguese (Brazilian), or German, you can automatically translate messages sent in different languages.

Remind helps save time

- No more outdated school websites or long newsletters. Remind messages are shorter than 300 characters and sent directly to your mobile phone.
- If you have the ability to compose a message, you can reach out to teachers or other parents in a class. Watch for teachers' office hours to see when you'll get the quickest response.
- Stay in touch on-the-go. Send PDFs, personalized voice clips, and quick photos of permission slips or assignments directly from your phone.

Signing up is easy

To join a Remind class, you'll need a class code from a teacher, coach, administrator, or organization leader. Each code is unique, but it always looks like this: **@classcode**.

Once you have a class code, there are three ways to join the class:

- 2 Go to www.remind.com/join/classcode and follow the directions.

GULF BREEZE HIGH SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARKING ON CAMPUS

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

Student Drivers and Parents:

Parking spaces on campus during the 2018/2019 school year will still be limited. It is for this reason that you should read carefully the rules and regulations listed below and be prepared to follow them during the school year.

NOTE:

1. You must have a current decal on your car to legally park on the main campus and at the field house.
2. Possession of a GBHS parking permit does not guarantee a parking space; the permit simply allows the student the opportunity to park legally on campus, which includes the field house, should a parking space be available.
3. All sophomores must park at the field house.
4. If the main campus is full, all overflow parking is at the field house or behind the stadium on Daniel Drive.
5. Parking at Gulf Breeze Middle School is strictly prohibited unless you have middle school permit. Parking at Gulf Breeze Elementary School is prohibited.
6. Students are **NOT** allowed to park in Senior Reserved spots unless they have paid for and been assigned to that parking spot.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:

1. Students should register their cars on the announced pre-registration days before the beginning of the school year. The fee for registering your car is **\$20.00**. Replacement decals are **\$10.00**.
2. Student decals will affix to the inside of the windshield, driver side, bottom corner.
3. Students must park only in designated parking areas (no backing into spaces).
4. Students are not to go to their cars during the course of the school day without expressed permission from Student Services (Assistant Principal, Dean, or SRO).
5. **PARKING VIOLATIONS – Students parked illegally on any part of the GBHS campus can be towed without warning at any time at the discretion of the administration.**
6. Students will **not** be allowed to park in areas reserved for faculty and staff or visitors. Students who park in these areas will receive a ticket*, and will be assigned detention ranging from afternoon to Saturday. Continued violations may result in the car being towed and/or loss of driving privileges.
7. Temporary use of an unregistered vehicle must be cleared through the Office of Student Services. A temporary sticker will be issued by Student Services/SRO and will be good for a maximum period of 5 days.

When a high school student is allowed to bring a vehicle on campus, the student assumes all responsibility for the vehicle and all contents found in the vehicle. Students who drive to school should be aware that school officials reserve the right to search vehicles any time, holding the student responsible for any item found in his/her car. If the administration finds an item that violates school and/or county rules, the student responsible for the vehicle will be penalized according to the tenets of these two sets of guidelines.

Some Helpful Information from Student Services

We are looking forward to a GREAT 2018-2019 school year. Two publications that contain the policies and procedures of Gulf Breeze High School and Santa Rosa School District are the Code of Student Conduct and the GBHS Student Handbook. They are available on the school website <http://www.gulfbreezehighschool.com/> under parent/student links. Health cards will be distributed on the first day and must be returned promptly. Students will not be able to check out without a completed health card on file.

School Shopping (Dress Guidelines)

Minimum length of skirts, dresses and shorts – must not be shorter than fingertip length when student's arms are extended down by their sides. If garments with holes are worn, there must be no holes less than fingertip length. Students are not to wear pants or shorts that show their underwear regardless of shirt length.

Students prohibited from wearing:

- Any garment/item or tattoo with obscene or offensive language, gestures, pictures or graphics, or drug, tobacco, or alcoholic beverage advertisement. (See Code of Conduct/Student Handbook for more dress code details)
- No Head coverings. Tank tops, halter tops, spaghetti strap blouses or dresses. Shoulders must be covered. No bedroom slippers.
- Students may not wear clothing that reveals undergarments or cleavage while sitting, standing or when one is moving. Extremely tight clothing will be deemed inappropriate. **(Administration reserves the right to determine what is appropriate and inappropriate for GBHS)**

Cell Phone Policies

The SRC School District has implemented significant changes to the use of mobile devices within the school setting. The mobile device shall be in silent mode during school hours, so noises from the device will not disrupt the educational environment. Students may use their mobile device at any time during NON-INSTRUCTIONAL time, unless specifically instructed **not** to do so by a member of the school staff. The following guidelines, however, must be strictly adhered to, and failure to do so can result in discipline up to and including out-of-school suspension.

- No photographing, videotaping, or audio recording to be done on school board property or at a school board function.
- No personal communication during instructional time, including that of relaying to others instructional materials such as test, quizzes, ect.
- The device must be in the silent mode and not disrupt the learning environment in any way.
- **The teacher has the authority to put into place individual guidelines related to mobile device use within his or her classroom.**
- **The student is solely responsible for personal property and neither the school nor School District shall bear any responsibility for lost, damaged, or stolen property brought by a student. For safety and security, students are strongly encouraged to secure mobile devices in a purse, book bag, ect.**

How to Handle Absences

Absences must be excused within three days. Parents may send a signed note or email the attendance clerk to excuse an absence/tardy. Please send a note the next day your student returns to school or email the day of the absence/tardy. If a student accumulates ten or more absences in a semester, written documentation (i.e. doctor's note, court summons, ect.) for any subsequent absences will be required to be excused. After 10 absences, a parent note or phone call will not excuse a student's absence.

Visitors and Volunteers

A valid Driver's License will be required for all visitors to enter GBHS. Please bring it upon entering the school.

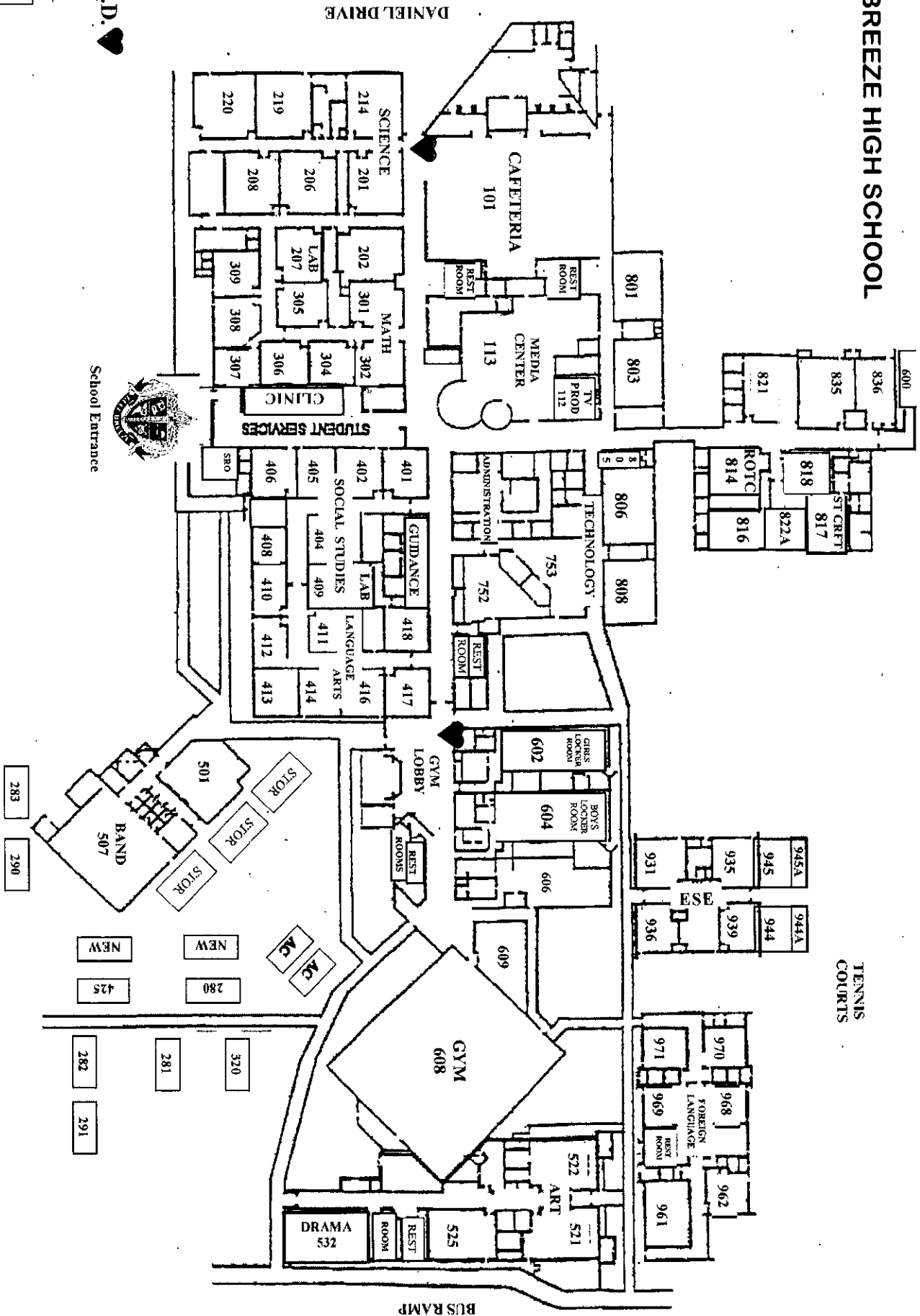

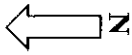


