The School play, CURTAINS will be performing at The Saenger Theater Friday the 20th of Apr. as well as Sunday, Apr. 22nd.

Secretary: Liz Mc. Requested the minutes from January and February be passed. Wei made the motion to approve with Kristin A. 2nd and the committee moved.

Treasurer: Kristin Amberson will follow up with the school treasurer Tiffine, regarding the funding of the PTSO Spring Grants from the curb painting receivables.

Principal: Danny Brothers reported- on April 14th about 51 students participated in the walk out for gun control. They used 17 minutes to represent the 17-people killed in the Parkland school shooting. He shared with the committee that it was a quiet demonstration. He also advised there will be walks and demonstrations in front of the school on 3/24 and 4/20 to honor the people lost in past school shootings.

Mr. Brothers described the job of the SRO and system of locking doors, fortifying security now and establishing a Buzz in system at student services. For 2018-2019 the SRO will provide funding in all its schools. He also confirmed the number of staff and officers at all school games in our Football stadium.

GBHS Mock Trial Team went to State 3/14, The ESE Best Buddies Festival 3/15, Key Club Parking Lot Clean Up 3/16.

We've retained a company to fix the School Sign out front on 98! The PTSO funded the \$2000. To repair, as the cost for new is \$19,000.

Teacher Rep.: Diane Folsie reported Industry Certification exams resulted in the State rewarding GBHS Academies with \$129,316.25.

John Hall (our custodian) has an interview to work for the county, rather than our school.

Grants: Suanne Landry not in attendance- Wei U. made a Motion to increase the Spring grant budget by \$981.55, it was 2nd by Diane F.

The Rabon/ESE grant for \$250. was relooked after gaining further insight. The motion to approve was brought by Kristin A. and 2nd by Wei and the committee passed.

Hospitality: Capri Welch advised the co-chair for hospitality Julie Giles, needs a new debit card for the acct.

Membership: Paula Sarkari – Brought the Blue and Gold Donor Plaques to be hung in the hallway.
