The council shall serve in an advisory capacity to the principal, assist in the development of educational programming, and participate in the School Improvement Plan (SIP) process.

Composition of the SAC

- Parents
- Community/Business Partners
- Principal
- Teachers
- Educational Support Employees
- Students

Expectations for SAC Members

- Attend monthly meetings (traditionally 0800-0900 once/month)
- Serve for a 2-year term
- Examine all aspects of the school when developing the School Improvement Plan (SIP)
- Help prioritize the needs of the school and develop strategies for improving areas of need
- Develop a plan for preparing and measuring the results of the SIP
- Assist in the preparation of the school's annual budget
- Decide how to spend the SAC funds (School Improvement and School Recognition)
- Assist in recruiting and retaining other SAC members
- Complete a District Volunteer/Background Check form
