Secretary's report: March's minutes were distributed and reviewed. Typo corrected and Linda Youberg's name added to attendance. Motion to approve minutes brought by Dan Hecht, seconded by Nathan Ford. Motion passed.

Principal's report:

- School Marquee: Principal Brothers thanked the SAC committee for the funds to replace the school marquee. Timeline is not clear on completion; hoping for before graduation. The Dolphin picture at the top of the sign will be replaced with LED lights.
- Overpass: GBHS is not in charge of the overpass- it is controlled by FLDOT
- 2018-2019 School Budget: Principal Brothers presented the projected school budget for 2018-2019. The only change was a gain of \$210 left from last year's budget; otherwise the budget remained the same. Motion to approve the budget brought by Anita Marie Hitchcock, seconded by Jim Docherty. Motion passed.
- Extracurricular events update:
 - Tennis: Girls and Boys won districts and will move to regionals
 - Indoor Percussion: going to Dayton, OH to compete
 - ITV/Newspaper/Yearbook: competed at state convention and did well
 - Drama: performing in "Curtains" at the Saenger Theater on 4/20@ 7:30pm and on 4/21@2:30 pm
 - Track & Field: Boys were 1st overall at district meet (first time in 17 years!) and Girls were 3rd. Both will move to regionals in Tallahassee.
 - Lacrosse: currently competing in districts; Boys still undefeated
 - Football: Blue/Gold game is 5/11
 - HOSA: performed well at state competition
 - Mock Trial Team: performed well at state competition in Orlando
 - One student (W.B.) competed in state weightlifting competition and placed 3rd.
- GoFan update: Athletic Director Matt Alt and SGA Sponsor Sarah Smith
 - GoFan in used in over 10,000 schools; no cost to use, easy accounting, detailed reports provided, digital and hard copy available
 - This program is used for all GBHS athletic events and school dances. FHSAA uses it for all of its' athletic events.
 - There were some difficulties with the GoFan app when it was used for Homecoming; for prom, tickets can be accessed via the app, the online platform, and can be shown as a screenshot on the phone.
 - There is a contingency plan in place to help students without computer/Internet access or who may have financial difficulty purchasing a ticket.
 - There is a service fee when tickets are purchased.

Budgets and Grants Report:

- Nathan Ford reported that there were no additional applications received from teachers
- The current amount in the budget is \$374.09.

Student representatives report:

 - Senior banquet is 5/9 @ Portofino. Cost is \$10 and tickets are currently on sale.
