1st order of business: to adopt meeting agenda. Accepted unanimously.

Secretary's report:

- September's minutes were sent to the committee for approval. Nathan Ford moved to approve, Shannon Spooneybarger seconded. Motion to approve minutes was passed. Minutes will be placed on school website.

Principal's report:

- Internet/call outs were unavailable for the last week or so due to issues with Internet throughout Santa Rosa County School District- seems to be up and running now.
- PSAT question from Dan Hecht submitted through email about junior students on the waiting list for PSAT- due to the delay from the storm days, were any more tests ordered for those on the wait list? Answer: No, all PSAT tests had to be ordered from CollegeBoard by September 12th of this year. All sophomores can take the test. Next year, there will be a two week window open for interested students to sign up for the PSAT before the ordering deadline.
- Lunch question from Jim Docherty: are lunches too full due to enrollment size? Answer: Lunches are full, but will using outside picnic area, all students have a place to sit. It can get tight when weather prevents outside seating.
- School updates:
 - Band: overall excellents at competition on 10/13 in Ft. Walton
 - Cross County: districts in two weeks
 - Golf: couple students placed in district game
 - Football: won Homecoming game; bye this week
 - Homecoming Dance: lots of students attended; over 800 tickets sold; DJ had some issues with the music cutting out
 - AP monies: did come in and been distributed appropriately
 - Student overflow parking is at the field house

Student representatives' report:

- SGA is collecting canned goods now until the GB/Navarre football game on 10/26. Cans can be dropped off in student services.

PTSO Representative report:

- PTSO has begun discussing Project Graduation- location has been secured
