



GBHS SENIORS-ONLY PAINTED PARKING SPOTS

SENIORS! You have the chance to paint your very own PARKING SPOT for the 2021-2022 school year! By filling out this form, you are eligible for one spot. If you are a senior for THIS school year and wish to participate, you must:

- Complete a 2021-2022 Senior Parking Spot Agreement packet to be turned into the GBHS front desk or at Senior Locker Day 7/29/2020
- Pay an ONLINE registration fee of \$95.00 ([Myschoolbucks.com School Store 7/12 - 7/29](https://myschoolbucks.com)) * **This fee includes Student parking decal (\$20.00). All proceeds from the \$75.00 registration fee are invested by PTSO in classroom grants, school programs and directly support GBHS.**
- Sign the acknowledgement of the general parking rules page.
- Submit a parking spot design for administrative approval by 7/29.
- Submit the Reserved Parking Space Request on My School Bucks (Open 7/12-7/29)

Eligible seniors will be painting their parking spot **on the dates below:**

Priority of space selection will be determined by time/date stamp of the payment of the \$95.00 registration fee. No spot will be assigned until all forms are completed. Every effort will be made to match one of your desired space choices. If for any reason you are unhappy with your parking space assignment, you may request a \$75.00 refund before August 3.

In order to follow all county and district codes, please read and sign the guidelines below for the painted parking spots stating that you will oblige and understand that if the guidelines aren't followed your privileges will be revoked.

Students driving to school must purchase a GBHS parking permit, present a current FL driver's license and valid insurance with the student's name listed on the policy, and have a license plate number in order to purchase a curb for your parking spot.

STUDENT PARKING SPACE RULES

1. You **MUST** purchase your own paint and brushes to use to decorate your parking spot. **WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT** is the only type of paint that can be used.
2. Student **MUST** clean spills and discard all unused materials. **NO PAINT OR TRASH OF ANY KIND MAY BE DISPOSED OF ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. STUDENTS ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR PAINT DISPOSAL OFF CAMPUS.**
3. PARKING STICKER MUST BE CLEARLY VISIBLE WHEN CAR IS PARKED IN THE SPOT.
4. HAVE FUN!!! The purpose of allowing students to paint their own parking spot is aimed at improving school pride and camaraderie. Students can "own" a piece of the school. We encourage students to express themselves through **POSITIVE** artwork.
5. Paint your name (at least your first name) somewhere in your spot. Please do not use nicknames.
6. **All designs must be pre-approved.** They are due no later than Monday, July 29th, 2021. There will be time to review designs and communicate with seniors any changes that need to be made.

Remember, purchasing a student parking spot is completely optional and this reservation does not guarantee you one of the spots. There will be parking spaces available for students who do not wish to purchase and decorate a space.

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration. Disciplinary and Criminal actions may be taken. If this happens, you will not only be forfeiting your right to a parking space and/or to drive on campus but you will also forfeit any monies collected.

- THIS Parking Spot Agreement form needs to be signed and turned in with your design.



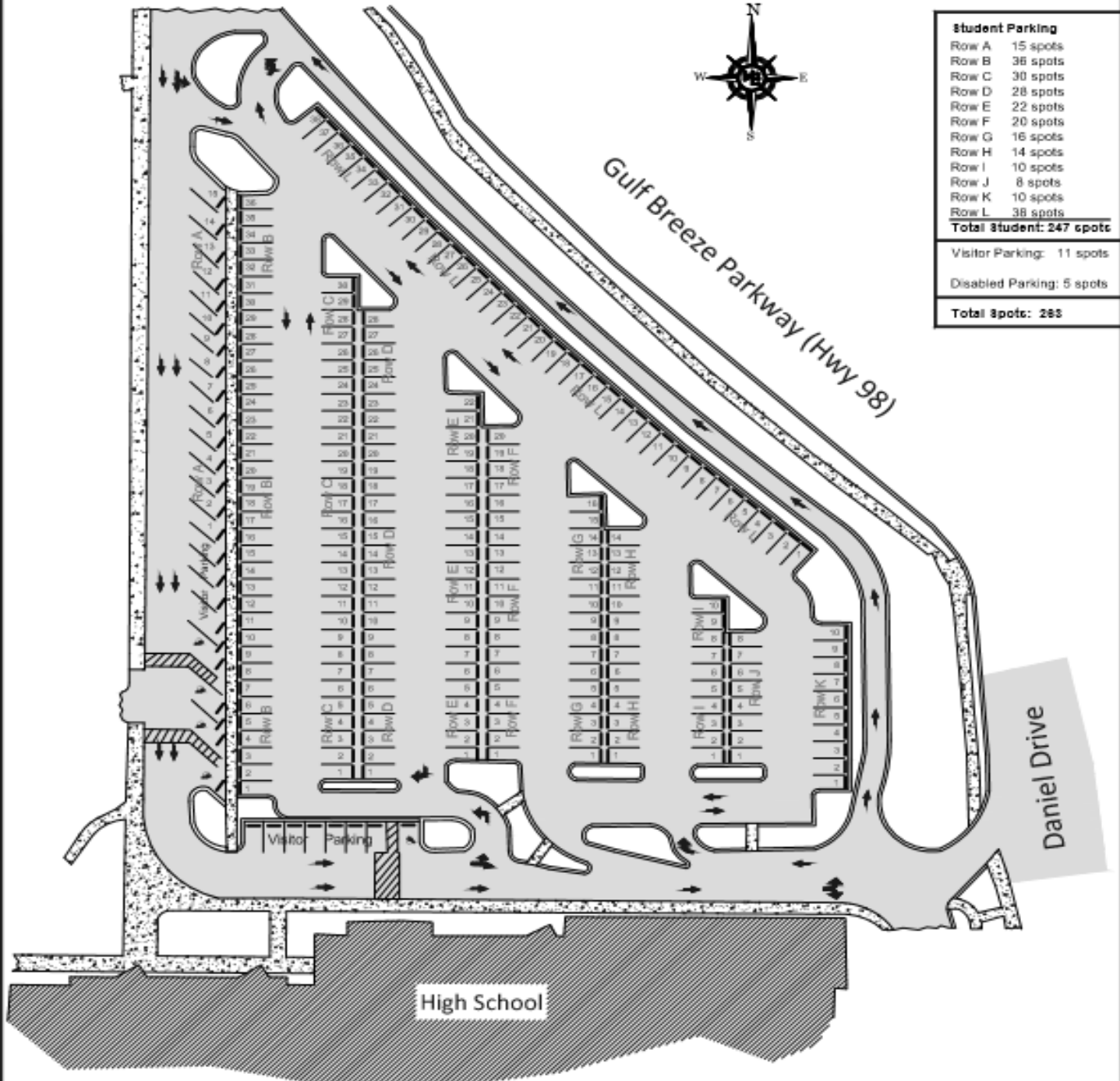

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARKING ON CAMPUS

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

Student Drivers and Parents:

Parking spaces on campus during the 2021-2022 school year will be limited. It is for this reason that you should read carefully the rules and regulations listed below and be prepared to follow them during the school year.

NOTE:

1. You must have a current decal on your car to legally park on the main campus and at the field house.
2. **Parking is not guaranteed!** Possession of a GBHS parking permit does not guarantee a parking space; the permit simply allows the student the opportunity to park legally on campus, which includes the field house, should a parking space be available.
3. All sophomores must park at the field house.
4. If the main campus is full, all overflow parking is at the field house.
5. Parking at Gulf Breeze Middle School is strictly prohibited unless you have a middle school parking decal. Parking at Gulf Breeze Elementary School is prohibited.
6. Students are **NOT** allowed to park in Senior Reserved spots unless they have paid for and been assigned to that parking spot.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:

1. Students will purchase their parking decal via the MySchoolBucks app before the beginning of the school year. The fee for registering your car is **\$20.00**. Replacement decals are **\$10.00**.
2. Student decals will affix to the inside of the front windshield, driver side, bottom corner.
3. Students must park only in designated parking areas (no backing into spaces).
4. Students are not to go to their cars during the course of the school day without expressed permission from Student Services (Assistant Principal, Dean, or SRO).
5. **PARKING VIOLATIONS – Students parked illegally on any part of the GBHS campus can be towed without warning at any time at the discretion of the administration.**
6. **Students will not be allowed to park in areas reserved for faculty and staff or visitors. Students who park in these areas will receive a ticket*. Continued violations may result in the car being towed and/or loss of driving privileges.**
7. Temporary use of an unregistered vehicle must be cleared through the Office of Student Services. A temporary sticker will be issued by Student Services/SRO and will be good for a maximum period of **5 days**.

When a high school student brings a vehicle on campus, the student assumes all responsibility for the vehicle and all contents found in the vehicle. Students who drive to school should be aware that school officials reserve the right to search vehicles any time, holding the student responsible for any item found in his/her car. If the administration finds an item that violates school and/or county rules, the student responsible for the vehicle will be penalized according to the tenets of these two sets of guidelines.
