In Attendance: Allyson Anderson, Kelli Filardi, Liz McCulley, Cyndi Massey, Paula Sarkari, Danny Brothers, Maddie Lunday, Christa Wilson

President: Allyson Anderson- brought meeting to order at 8:07 and welcomed committee. Allyson also confirmed there will be a PTSO table set up during the Middle School parent Mtg. on 4/9.
