- Mr. Brothers presented the 2019-2020 school based budget to the SAC committee. The budget is similar to the previous budget, with an increase of \$3661.00 for a total of \$113,970.00. - Coach Ryan Williams, won the 3A State Girls Soccer Coach of the Year.
- Track districts- Girls finished 2nd, Boys finished 3rd.
- Tennis- Girls team won districts and moving on.
- Girls LAX were district champs and play tonight at 6:00.
- Boys LAX plays tomorrow night in districts.
- Girls weightlifting represented at state with two students: S. Doerr and R. French.
- Boys Baseball- senior night was 4/16 with a win against Pace.
- ROTC participated in a tribute march on Hwy. 98 to recognize the Bataan Death March.
